

COVID-19 STUDENT FLOWCHART – as from 1st March 2022

Student feels unwell with COVID-19 symptoms

Student who has no COVID-19 symptoms tests positive on a Lateral Flow Test (LFT) taken at home

Student lives with, or has stayed overnight with, a person who has tested positive for COVID-19

Student contacts the College on 0800 854 695 and chooses the Covid Reporting option or contacts a member of staff directly

Staff member advises student to self-isolate whilst waiting for test results

Staff member advises student to self-isolate in line with current government guidance

Student attends College

Student informs staff member on arrival at College

Staff member advises student to arrange a PCR test

Student social distances whilst at College

Student wears a face covering whilst at College

Staff member contacts covid@eastcoast.ac.uk with details

Teacher makes arrangements for student to work from home

Types of Test
PCR - Polymerase Chain Reaction – a test taken at home or at a testing centre and then analysed at a laboratory with result known on 2-3 days
LFT – Lateral Flow Test – a test taken at home or at a testing centre where result is known after 30 minutes

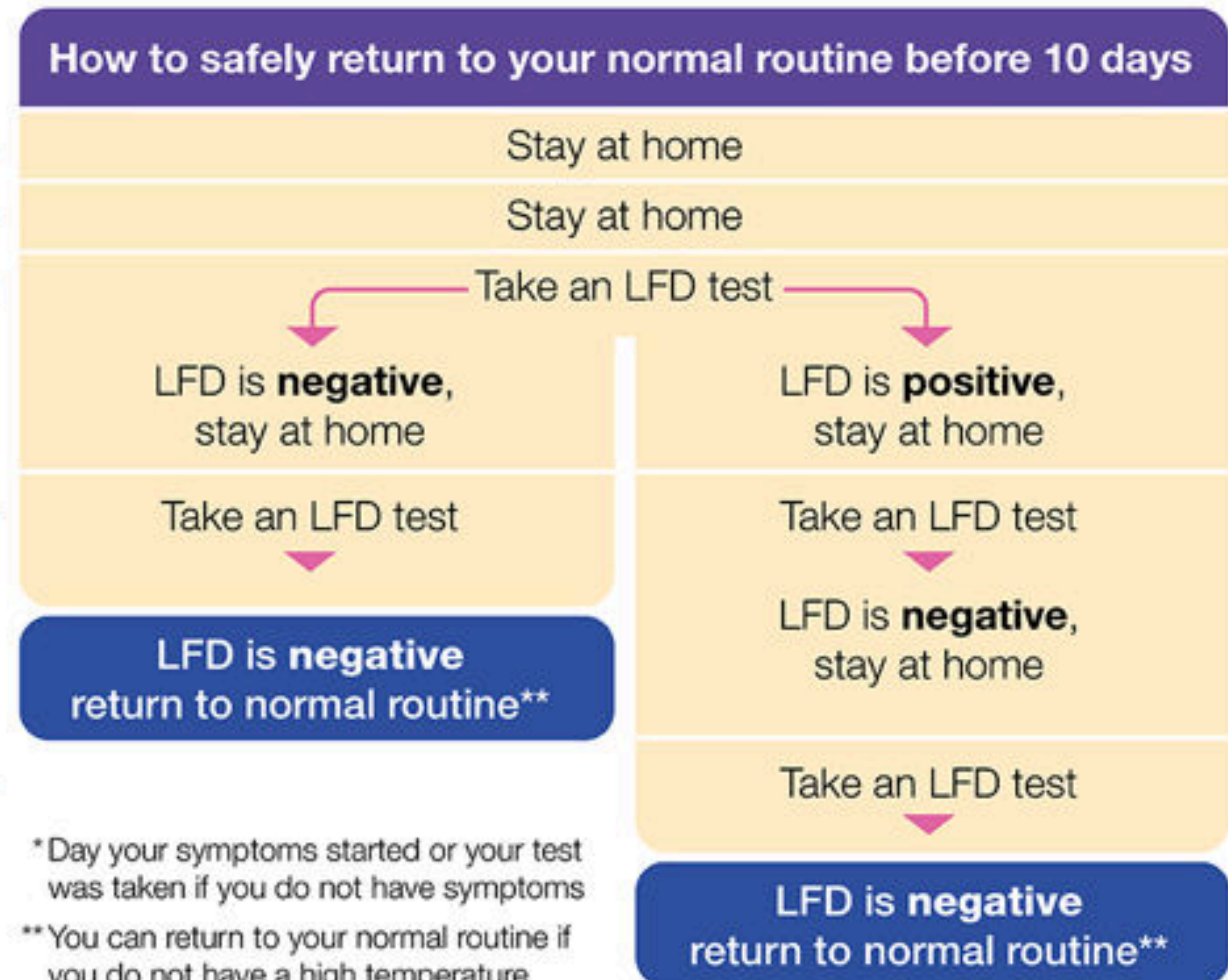
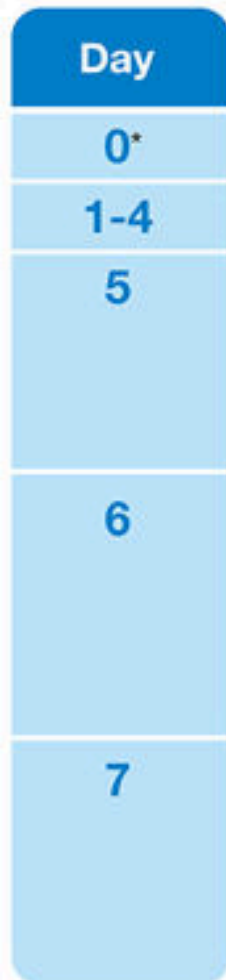
